

The Jahan is Heritage Line's most romantic cruise liner. This magnificent vessel was named after the Indian emperor Shah Jahan who ruled the Mughal Empire from 1628 to Particulars 1658. SUPERIOR STATEROOMS

All twelve Superior Staterooms (four twins, eight doubles) feature light red tones and a fine selection of artwork mounted on walls and ceilings to a crème-white backdrop. The Superior Staterooms are situated on the main deck. All are fitted with white wood furnishings, hand-painted (4 sqm) with chairs and table, individually wall-to-ceiling décor, and a queen-size bed. The 30 sqm (322 sqft) room includes a spacious 4 sqm (43 sqft) private balcony. A cozy lounge corner invites guests to observe life on the river banks through floor-to-ceiling windows. The bathroom includes a large walk-in shower.


