

# LUANG PRABANG - CHIANG RAI DAILY ITINERARY [UPSTREAM]

Day 1 Upon arrival in Luang Prabang, you'll be whisked away to your luxurious retreat at the Rosewood Luang Prabang. Take the rest of the day to unwind and enjoy the hotel's exceptional amenities. For those seeking a bit of adventure, consider optional activities like a private cooking class, or borrow a complimentary bicycle to explore the charming streets of the town. Cycle through peaceful lanes, and perhaps stop at a local café for a refreshing coffee. As evening falls, savour a delicious dinner at the hotel or venture into town for a meal (not included), where you can also visit the lively night market. Dining: -

① Pick-up at airport, train station or in Luang Prabang town (guest to advise). Check-in time is 14:00hrs (early check-in is complimentary subject to room availability.

Day 2 Start your day at dawn with the enchanting century-old tradition of "Tak Bat" (self-arranged via hotel tuk-tuk), where locals gather in the heart of Luang Prabang to offer sticky rice and fruits to monks in a peaceful sunrise procession. Witnessing this serene ritual from a respectful distance is a truly memorable experience. Afterward, return to the hotel and indulge in a lavish breakfast to begin your day.

The rest of the day is yours to enjoy as you wish. Take advantage of the hotel's complimentary spa treatment to relax and rejuvenate. In the evening, treat yourself to a delectable multi-course Laotian meal at the romantic 'Manda de Lao,' widely regarded as one of the finest restaurants in town. Conclude your unforgettable stay in Luang Prabang before embarking on tomorrow's upstream cruise into the heart of the Golden Triangle. Dining: B, D

Day 3 After a delightful breakfast, you will be transferred to the downtown pier to embark on a four-day voyage aboard the boutique ship, Heritage Line 'Anouvong.' As you sail along the Mekong River through the Golden Triangle toward Northern Thailand, settle into your luxurious cabin before attending an insightful lecture on Laos' diverse ethnic groups in the ship's lounge. The first highlight of the journey is a visit to the sacred Pak Ou Caves, home to around 4,000 revered Buddhist statues. Explore the impressive lower cave before choosing from two optional excursions: an adventurous kayak tour along the tranquil Nam Ou River or a visit to the nearby village of Ban Muang

Keo, renowned for its traditional silk weaving and Lao whisky distillation. The voyage then continues to the 200-year-old village of Ban Khok Phou, where the locals, part of the Lao ethnic group, practise mountain farming. The visit culminates with a traditional Baci ceremony, performed by village elders to bestow blessings upon your journey. As night falls, enjoy a welcome cocktail on an elevated sandbank, followed by a mouthwatering barbecue dinner amidst the breathtaking natural surroundings. Dining: B, L, D

Day 4 Start your day with a refreshing yoga session on the terrace deck before enjoying a delicious breakfast. The morning brings a stop at a picturesque village inhabited by Khmu people. Here, you can mingle and meet with different generations who deeply rooted in the land, sustaining their livelihood through manual agriculture. In the afternoon, the journey continues to another village along the Mekong, where the Hmong, Lao Loum, and Khamo ethnic groups live in harmony. A visit to a family home provides an intimate look into the distinct histories and traditions of each group, offering a vivid complement to the insights from earlier lectures. As evening approaches, enjoy a traditional dance performance on the open deck, followed by a cosy cinema night in the lounge. The featured film, "Chiang," which was shot in this region in 1927, will transport you back in time and set the tone for the next day's adventure. Dining: B, L, D

Day 5 As the Anouvong continues its upstream journey, start your day with a post-breakfast bamboo weaving workshop. The rest of the morning is yours to enjoy at your leisure-whether it's indulging in the spa, working out in the gym, or simply daydreaming as the stunning scenery passes by. After lunch, the ship arrives at Pakbeng, where you'll visit Laos' most sustainable elephant sanctuary, nestled deep in the jungle along the riverside. In an almost pristine natural setting, we have the privilege of encountering these majestic creatures. Learn about the sanctuary's vital work and meet elephants roaming freely in their natural habitat, offering an unforgettable wildlife experience. As the ship continues its northbound course, it will anchor for your final night on board. 

# CHIANG RAI - LUANG PRABANG DAILY ITINERARY

Day 1 Your journey begins with a transfer from Chiang Rai to the Four Seasons Tented Camp Golden Triangle resort. Depending on your arrival time, you can spend the rest of the day relaxing at the resort or explore the area on your own. For a local cultural experience, consider a visit to the Opium Museum. Dining: -

① Pick-up at the airport or Chiang Rai town (guest to advise). Check-in time is 14:00hrs (early check-in is complimentary subject to room availability).

Day 2 After breakfast, set out on a morning exploration of local life and cultural wonders with a knowledgeable camp guide. Cruise down the Mekong River in a traditional longtail boat, discovering the Golden Triangle where Thailand, Myanmar, and Laos converge. Immerse yourself in the vibrant local scene, hopping between songtaews and tuk-tuks to explore bustling markets. Seek tranquility at the ancient Chedi Luang temple before returning to the resort for lunch. In the afternoon, choose from another adventure: the "My Elephant & I" experience, where you'll accompany elephants in their natural habitat for an unforgettable encounter. Alternatively, unwind with a happy hour sunset cocktail or indulge in a range of relaxing treatments at the resort's spa before dinner. Dining: B, L, D

Day 3 After an early breakfast, the resort transfers you to the Thai-Lao border. After immigration formalities, the Heritage Line cruise team awaits to transfer you to the ship. During the following four-day voyage aboard the boutique ship Heritage Line 'Anouvong' you traverse the golden triangle on the Mekong River towards the enchanting town of Luang Prabang in Laos. A lecture about Laos' ethnic groups is offered at the ship's lounge whilst sailing to the first stop of the day. The first village is inhabited by the Tai Lu ethnic group spanning across China, Laos, Thailand, Burma, and Vietnam. The highpoint is a traditional Baci ceremony, performed together with the local elders, bestowing us their blessings for this journey. As the night falls, the cruise manager invites you to a welcome cocktail on the elevated sandbank, followed by a barbecue dinner amid astonishing natural beauty. Dining: B, L, D

Day 4 Start your day with a revitalising yoga session on the terrace deck before breakfast. This morning's voyage brings us to the charming town of Pakbeng. Here, nestled in the lush jungle along the riverside, is Laos' most sustainable elephant sanctuary. Discover the unique features of this sanctuary and meet elephants roaming freely in their natural rainforest habitat for an unforgettable wildlife experience. It is a one-of-a-kind encounter to see these gentle creatures appear out of nowhere in the rainforest and learn interesting things about them. As the ship continues its journey southbound at lunchtime, participate in a bamboo weaving workshop to pass the time until we reach Khok Fk River hamlet. In this vibrant community, where Hmong, Lao Loum, and Khamo ethnic groups coexist, visit a local family home to gain insight into the distinct histories and traditions of each group. Before dinner, enjoy a traditional dance performance on the open deck. Afterwards, relax in the lounge with a classic film screening of "Chiang," a 1927 movie filmed in the region. Dinina: B. L. D

Day 5 Start your day with an invigorating sunrise yoga session to boost your energy. After breakfast, we'll visit a picturesque village inhabited by the Khmu people. This tranguil locale features bamboo huts elevated on stilts amidst expansive rice fields. Here, you'll meet local residents, including elderly couples and multigenerational families who sustain their livelihoods through traditional agriculture. Returning to the ship, enjoy lunch as we continue our journey to our overnight mooring spot. Once docked, explore the charming 200-year-old village of Ban Khok Phou, whose inhabitants are primarily from the Lao ethnic group. From the village square, observe the local life and immerse yourself in the community's daily activities. As night falls, enjoy a cocktail on the sandbank, followed by a farewell dinner meticulously arranged in this perfect setting. Dining: B, L, D

Day 6 Before reaching Luang Prabang, we will visit the renowned Pak Ou Caves in the morning. These sacred caves house approximately 4,000 Buddhist statues. You'll explore the impressive lower cave and then choose between two exciting options: an adventurous kayak tour along the tranquil Nam Ou River or a visit to the nearby village of Ban Muang Keo, known for its traditional silk weaving and Lao whisky distillation.

Back on board, a cooking class will kick off the lifestyle segment of the day just before lunchtime. Enjoy a delicious brunch served until about an hour before arrival as you continue to soak in the journey. A captivating presentation will delve into the history of the Golden Triangle, exploring the complexities of colonialism, the opium trade, conflicts, and the roles played by Burma, Thailand, Laos, Britain, and China. We will arrive at the pier in Luang Prabang around three o'clock in the afternoon, where a Rosewood Resort staff member will be waiting to transfer you to the hotel. Once settled, you can either relax and enjoy the exceptional facilities at the resort or explore the charming town of Luang Prabang on a complimentary bicycle provided by the hotel. Pedal through the serene streets and stop for coffee at one of the local cafés. As evening falls, you can choose to dine at the hotel or venture into town (dining not included), where you can also visit the bustling night market. Dining: B, L

Day 7 Start your day at dawn to witness the ancient tradition of alms giving, known as "Tak Bat" (arranged independently via the hotel's tuk-tuk). In this serene sunrise procession, locals gather in the town centre to offer sticky rice and fruits to monks. Observing this ritual from a respectful distance provides a truly exceptional experience in Luang Prabang. After soaking in this early-morning tradition, return to the hotel for a sumptuous breakfast. The rest of the day is yours to enjoy at your leisure. Take advantage of a complimentary spa treatment at the hotel's spa to relax and rejuvenate.



### KUANG SI WATERFALL GETAWAY

Spend a half-day discovering the stunning Kuang Si Waterfall, located just an hour's drive from Luang Prabang. Begin your adventure with a guided visit to one of the town's key landmarks, Wat Xieng Thong temple. After exploring the temple, we drive to the Kuang Si Park. Immerse yourself in the lush natural beauty with a leisurely hike, swim in the crystal-clear waters, and visit the Asian Bear Rescue Center. Enjoy a refreshing dip in the cool, turquoise pools, and if you hike to the top of the falls, you'll find tranquil ponds often to yourself. Savour some picnic snacks before returning to Luang Prabang.

### LUANG PRABANG BY BICYCLE

Explore the charming and tranquil town of Luang Prabang on a delightful cycling tour. Venture to the outskirts of town to witness traditional handicrafts, such as the unique saa paper-making process or observe skilled craftsmen creating intricate wooden sculptures. After your tour, enjoy a leisurely lunch at one of the charming cafés or restaurants in the heart of Luang Prabang before heading back to the hotel.

### CYCLING OFF THE BEATEN PATH

Embark on a half-day cycling adventure outside Luang Prabang, exploring waterfalls, rustic villages, and experiencing local charm. Begin by cycling to the Mekong River, where you'll board a local boat (with your bike) for a 30-minute downstream journey. Upon disembarking, continue cycling to the scenic Hoy Khua waterfall, where you'll enjoy a picnic lunch. The tour then takes you through picturesque Lao villages on mostly flat terrain, offering a glimpse into the daily lives of the local people. Afterward, paddle back to the river and return to Luang Prabang by boat, concluding your adventure at your hotel.

### BUDDHIST ARCHIVE OF PHOTOGRAPHY

For the past 120 years, Buddhist monks in Luang Prabang have meticulously documented and photographed monastic ceremonies, meditation practices, and pilgrimages. More than 35,000 of these photographs have been discovered across 21 monasteries in Luang Prabang. Supported by the British Library's Endangered Archives Programme, this extensive collection including original photos has been digitalize at achrived at Wat Khili (not open to the public). Engage with an expert from the Buddhist Archive to gain a deeper understanding of this remarkable collection and its historical significance. Over a cup of tea, delve into discussions and enjoy a unique, immersive experience of Luang Prabang's rich Buddhist heritage.
